**TOWNSHIP WORK CONSISTED OF:**

- . Kodiak to center auto to diagnose electrical issue... Needed both front wheel speed sensors and tone rings cleaned off, taken back to eagle for final inspection
- . Elgin sweeper picked up from A+H equipment, taken to eagle towing for servicing and inspection
- . Work plan drawn up for sweeping for PennDOT, Walker township, Potter township, Centre Hall borough
- . Assisted the water authority on south main street repairing a yard and bank that was torn up with a water leak
- . All trash picked up along all main roadways a total of 47 bags of trash were picked up
- . All yard complaints that came in over the winter were repaired that included raking the old sod, laying down new topsoil, straw, and new grass seed,
- . Started sweeping streets in the township, finished in two weeks with 8 loads of material brought back to the township building
- . Started sweeping in walker township
- . Dug electric lines out for Norman Avenue Street lights
