TOWNSHIP WORK CONSISTED OF:

- . Installed new street sign on first Ave that required a new sign, stub and post. Repaired township yard with new topsoil seed and straw
- . Collected more leaf piles that came out after we went through with the leaf truck. A total of 5 piles were picked up by hand.
- . Pulled weeds, sprayed, and gathered all piles of sticks up from winter in the township flowerbeds
- . Repaired township yard where old playground equipment was with topsoil, grass seed and straw
- . Ordered one load of topsoil and had it delivered to our Musser shed location
- . Swept pleasant gap fire station parking lot
- . Started / finished sweeping center hall borough
- . Started / finished sweeping potter township
- . Started / finished sweeping PennDOT for our agreement and trade on berm cutting to happen in august
- . Replaced main center broom on Elgin sweeper due to ware, replaced door latch, taped right suction hose that had a tear in it due to wear
- . Grant was awarded for new leaf truck, called multiple vendors to spec out a machine for prices and availability, A+h equipment, Stephenson equipment, Bradco
- . Filled in overdue locations with washed out berms, Weaver hill road, 180 weaver hill road, Wrishel hill
- . Took delivery of our brand-new tractor mounted broom and water tank, swept all main roads and took off, washed and cleaned
- . Cleaned up trees that fell on molasses hill due to high winds
