TOWNSHIP WORK CONSISTED OF:

- . Finished berms with a total of 9 truckloads of new (DSA) putt down on Sunnyside, Weaver hill Roopsburg, Penn eagle industrial park, wrishel hill road, greens valley road
- . Meeting with rock view guard and manager about more tree trimming and other services that they can do. Gregory lane, forge road, Valentine hill, Roopsburg road, North Allegany Street will all be getting trimmed the beginning of November tentatively
- . New screws added to the township building roof top, all old screw disposed of with a total of 2000 plus new screws added
- . Issues with JCB loader, called Hooper tractor for repairs, New front cylinder for 4-wheel steering repaired along with transmission hose
- . Ram t tags to beaver springs for recalls on wheel studs (none needed the recall)
- . Training for trench safety, also one day of training for dirt and gravel roads for a free 5-year recertification
- . Dig out marble lane berm, replaced stone with a #3 stone for better water drainage, cleaned out driveway
- . 1125 west spring field fixed yard with top soil, grass seed and straw
- . Added crosswalk with Bellefonte borrows stencils to the front of the united Methodist church
- . Installed an inlet box, Inlet top, and new grate on Airport Road Near the Bellefonte borough line. The water was continuing to cause damage at the road surface and needed to be added for proper drainage
- . Finished paving for the year on Jacksonville Road fixing three critical spots. Milling out these spots and adding 8 ton of new asphalt was needed. We cleaned up all the paving equipment, paver was cleaned and put away in storage for the year, returned milling head

. Trimmed back trees at the entrance of Robinson Lane, witherite road near the second farm road due to low branches

. Fall brush collection completed with a total of 34 truckloads of brush hauled to the Bellefonte Bourgh dump site.

. New Township sign out front had new conduit and wires ran for the lights, Sod removed from the surface, new sign installed, retain wall block cut and placed, dirt added to the top of blocks, lights were rewired, Black mulch and flowers were planted and we are only waiting on the cap blocks to be delivered for final completion
